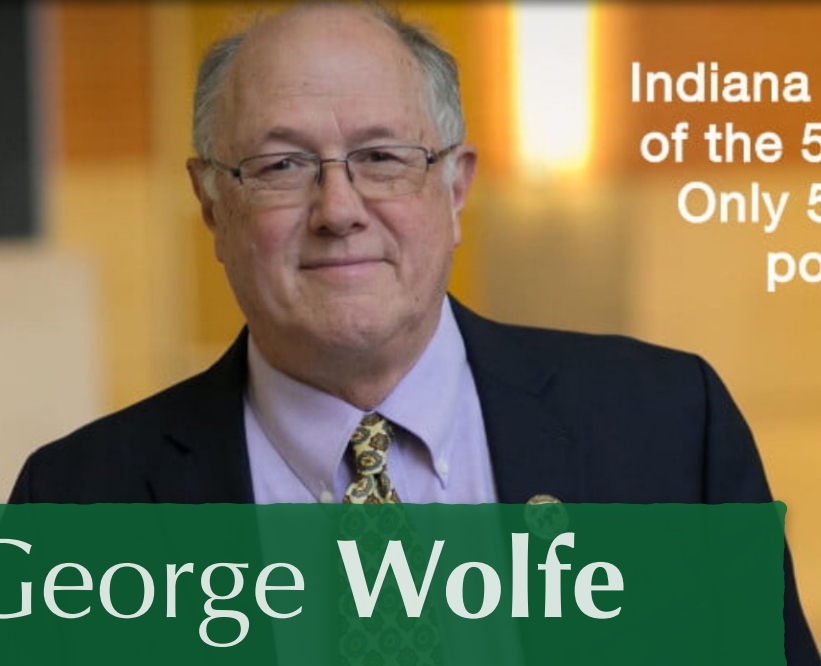


IT'S TIME TO RECLAIM AND RE-ENERGIZE OUR DEMOCRACY!

As Indiana's chief election official, I pledge to pursue the following sixteen-point plan to restore public confidence in our democracy and promote Hoosier entrepreneurs.

### Expanded 16-Point Green Party Plan for Indiana

1. Dramatically increase voter participation among all age, gender, ethnic, religious and secular demographic groups across Indiana;
2. Establish Election Day as a statewide holiday;
3. End gerrymandering by taking redistricting from the hands of politicians and setting up a nonpartisan citizen's redistricting commission;
4. Expand early voting opportunities;
5. Eliminate obstacles to voting; end voter suppression;
6. Facilitate legal voter registration across all demographic groups and provide same-day registration;
7. Pressure lawmakers to pass a hate crimes bill;
8. Provide more tax incentives to businesses to make use of solar, wind power and other green energy sources, and for auto dealers to boost sales of hybrid and electric vehicles;
9. Allow public colleges and universities in Indiana to offer in-state tuition to DACA students;
10. Raise the minimum wage to make it more competitive with Michigan and adjust the state minimum wage annually according to the rate of inflation; insist on equal pay for equal work; reward businesses that pay higher than minimum wage;
11. Preserve and promote preventative health initiatives such as free vaccines and yearly wellness exams;
12. Legalize medical marijuana;
13. Provide support for businesses that help young working parents with the cost of child daycare;
14. Pressure lawmakers to provide more support for child welfare agencies because of the opioid drug crisis;
15. Institute an educational program for Hoosier citizens on the United States Constitution; &
16. Insist on de-escalation training for community police.

Only a Secretary of State that is from outside the two major political parties can accomplish these ambitious goals & restore public faith & confidence in our democracy.
